Each rider or in-hand handler pays a \$20 fee, and people who come just to picnic and hang out are welcome at no charge. There's plenty of parking, as well as overnight camping (for a small extra fee)

You don't have to ride a Mustang or Burro, although they are encouraged. "In-hand" horses & donkeys are also welcome, of course, as well as domestic horses & donkeys.

Running I Ranch is a great "Equine Playground" with several acres of Trail Trial-type obstacles, two nice big arenas, round pen, parking, picnic grounds, and fishpond.
